#### **Population Health Management**

Question: How do Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland (LLR) figures for preventable deaths compare to

national figures?

**Answer:** LLR is in the 60<sup>th</sup> percentile.

Question: Can PPGS have more detailed population data for their locality?

Answer: Much of the data can be broken down to a locality level. If you have a specific request for data,

Question: How up to date is the data?

Answer: The data that the Integrated Care Board (ICB) uses is from a variety of sources, so some data

collections are much more recent than others and can vary from months to years.

Question: Does the smoking data include vaping?

Answer: Not at present.

Comment: Data needs to be reliable but the quality of clinical coding from primary care staff is

questionable.

Comment: NHS data does not include private healthcare.

Comment:

Question: It can be difficult to get data for more affluent areas, such as Rutland, because data is focussed on the most deprived areas.

**Answer:** There are different inequalities in rural areas and accessing healthcare can be an issue due to distance and transport.

**Question**: There are issues bordering counties using different clinical systems and staff not having access to medical records of patients who live in LLR. Will this be resolved?

**Answer:** We're further ahead than ever before with summary care records and shared care records, but there is more work to do.

There were several comments and questions around understanding what records are available via the NHS App and the difference between summary care records, GP care records and shared care records, and the rules around consent for each of these records. As this is an area of interest to the PPG Network, we will revisit these topics at a future Network meeting.
